The deck would run 40-feet along the house and extend 15 feet toward the lake. The only problem was ten feet (400 square feet of decking floor) of the extension would be within the 75-foot setback requirement of state law and county shoreland protection ordinances. After being cited for violating the setback requirements, Propp decided to reduce the decking floor by five feet, leaving her with 200 square feet within the setback, for which she applied for a special land use permit under state law and county ordinance. The change left the deck support system in place, but without decking on five feet. The county zoning department denied the permit, arguing the substructure encroached on the setback requirement.</p> <p>Ultimately, a Sauk County Circuit Court reversed the decision not to grant the permit and the county appealed. The Appeals Court affirmed the circuit court and rejected the county's argument the flooring on the deck should include the area outside the setback requirement when figuring the total space.
