## MAINTENANCE OF THE GF10 FILTER


We recommend the GF10 filter be cleaned when the septic tank is normally cleaned and pumped, or as needed. Although they may be different, most regulatory agencies suggest two to five years A time frame in which septic tanks are serviced is set by state and local codes.

## WARNING: If the liquid level in the tank is above the top of the filter, pump the tank prior to removing the filter cartridge.

Step 1: Remove the septic tank cover and pump the tank if necessary to prevent any solids from escaping to the field when the filter is removed.



Step 2: Pull the filter handle and slide the filter out of the case.



off with fresh water. Take care to make sure all solid material falls back into the tank. Step 3: While holding the filter cartridge over the access opening of the tank, rinse the cartridge



Step 4: Insert the cartridge back into the case making sure that it is properly aligned and completely inserted into the case.
