STIPULATION AND ORDER FOR DISMISSAL

STIPULATION


IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between Door County (hereafter "County") [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] (hereafter "Defendants"), as follows:

- A. This matter may be dismissed without costs or prejudice to either party, subject to the following:
 1. Defendants will cease and desist from making, exhibiting or selling items (including signs and chainsaw carvings) at or from the subject property. If Defendants wish to engage in these activities, they must first contact a County zoning administrator to determine if such is permissible and then apply for and obtain any required (regular zoning or conditional use) permit from the County's Planning Department.
 2. Defendants will, on or before March 15, 2016, remove (altogether or from view) any existing signs located on, and not place any additional sign at, the subject property. This includes the trailer with [REDACTED] painted on the side. If Defendants wish to have any signage, including a sign painted on the barn wall, they must first contact a County zoning administrator to determine if such is permissible and then apply for and obtain any required sign permit from the County's Planning Department.
 3. Defendants shall reimburse the fees and cost incurred by the County in bringing and prosecuting this action. These fees and costs total eighty dollars (\$80.00). This sum must be paid to County by March 1, 2016.
 4. Defendants will have no new similar violations of the Door County Zoning Ordinance at the subject property.

- B. If Defendants comply with Paragraph A., 1 – 4 above, this case will be deemed to be resolved.
- C. If Defendants fail to comply with Paragraph A., 1, 2, 3 or 4 above, County is entitled, upon application, proof by affidavit and with notice to each Defendant, to reopen this Order of Dismissal and to the entry of a judgment consistent with the demands of the Complaint.
- D. Defendants understand that the County's Corporation Counsel represents the County, and cannot provide them legal advice or representation.
- E. Defendants each acknowledge having had ample opportunity to confer with the attorney of their choice and having read and fully understands this Stipulation and Order of Dismissal.
