

## WCCA ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES

- 1) President Thiele called the meeting to order at 10:00am.
- 2) Introductions: People present: Robin Haasis, Chris Mrdutt, Daniel Lefebvre, Austin Dyb, Kenneth Thiele, Chris Meuer, Dustin Grant, Dan Bowers, Keith Lane, Alex Forster, Adam Adank. Virtual attendees: Scott Godfrey, Maija Wehmas, state agency representatives.
- 3) Changes or additions to the agenda: Dyb reports he is going to City of New London which means that he will start a new position in February pending council approval and will need to step down from the executive board. Thiele add 1<sup>st</sup> VP under action items.

- 6) **Treasurer's Report** – Robin Haasis (Schaffer), Secretary/Treasurer: Haasis reports that there is \$14,578.73 in the checking, \$1,030.76 in the scholarship, and \$18,381.11 in the money market. All of 2025 expenses have been paid and closed. Meuer/Mrdutt make motion to approve treasurer's report. Motion carried.

Godfrey reports that the Stoney Creek in La Crosse, Chula Vista, and Dellshire in Wisconsin Dells reaches out about setting up contracts. Chula Vista would be more expensive than last year's conference with a \$500.00 room charge. Discussion to look into Stoney Creek in La Crosse for Fall Conference.

    - i. **New logo**

The logo contest is closed and votes are done. Tyler Betry is the winner of the logo contest and has already made it known that the Wisconsin map with the district boundaries can be edited to account for the new district lines.

ii. **Logo licensing**

The logo cannot be renewed yet; it can only be renewed 60 days prior to expiration date. The existing logo will be used until the official renewal of the trademark with the new logo.

- a) Wisconsin Counties Association – Collin Driscoll gives update on current legislation matters. AB 449 Accessory Dwelling Units is not currently moving on to the Assembly. Thiele brings extraterritorial zoning, ability for the governor to veto and data centers up for discussion and potential topics for future presentations.
- b) WI Department of Ag, Trade and Consumer Protection – Ted Tuchalski- Not able to attend, sent an email update. Wis. Admin. Code. ch. ATCP 72 Hotel, Motel, Tourist Rooming Houses has now been finalized and will be in effect on January 25, 2026. These changes impact operational and compliance requirements for all hotel, motel, and tourist rooming house establishments. Sue reports they are currently reviewing 16 Shoreland Ordinances, with more counties ready to submit their final drafts. - g) WI Dept. of Safety and Professional Services – Matt Janzen arrived at 9:35 am. Janzen reports there is a Design class training this week.
